



## Soft plastics recycling arrives in Nelson-Tasman

You can now recycle plastic shopping bags, chip packets, bread bags and other soft plastics with the arrival of the Love NZ Soft Plastic Recycling Programme in our region.

Drop-off points will be available at all New World, Countdown and PakiSave stores in the region.

The Love NZ Soft Plastic Recycling Programme is a voluntary, industry led initiative where everyone involved in the life cycle of a product — manufacturers, distributors and consumers — choose to share responsibility for the best end-of-life outcome.

The programme takes all soft plastic bags including bread bags, frozen food bags, toilet paper packaging, confectionery and biscuit wrap, chip bags, pasta and rice bags, courier envelopes, shopping bags and sanitary hygiene packaging and turns

New Zealanders currently use around 1.6 billion plastic bags in the home every year. That means 4.3 million are being thrown away every day.

Tasman Mayor Richard Kempthorne says: "It's fantastic that people in our region can now recycle soft plastics, successfully diverting much of the packaging that currently ends up in our landfill. Congratulations to the industry for taking responsibility for the full lifecycle of their products."

"Recycling of soft plastics supports our overall aim to reduce waste to landfill, which includes both recycling and reducing the use of single-use bags!"

How it works

- Collect your soft plastics — make sure they are clean and dry
- Drop into your nearest collection point (please do not put them in your kerbside recycling bin)
- The programme will recycling them into fitness circuits, outdoor furniture, bollards and other products.

**SportStart**

No child should ever miss out on playing club/school sport. Sportstart is a funding initiative available from Sport Tasman for families who need financial assistance to pay their child/ren's subs when the going gets tough.
